NOTICE

This Ministry is examining a proposal for amendment to the existing Recruitment Rules for various Group A posts in the CDL Kolkata, CDTL Chennai, CDTL Mumbai, RDTL Chandigarh and RDTL Guwahati and to introduce common RRs for the Group A posts in all the Central Drugs Laboratories. Promotions to the vacant posts under the common RRs will be on the basis of the combined seniority of the officers in the feeder categories in the Central Drugs Laboratories. In this regard, draft Recruitment Rules have been prepared and are enclosed,

2. Before finalizing the Recruitment Rules in consultation with DoP&T, and UPSC, comments, if any, are invited from all stakeholders in the matter within a period of thirty days from the date of notification in the website of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare. The objections/suggestions received from the stakeholders within the specified period shall be considered by the Ministry as per rules/requirement.
