NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the ....., 2021.

G.S.R.... - In exercise of the powers conferred by proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, and in supersession of the Safdarjung Hospital/ Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital/ Lady Hardinge Medical College and Smt. Sucheta Kriplani Hospital /Kalawati Saran Education and Research , Pondicherry (Nursing Sister and Staff Nurse ) Recruitment Rules ,1997 in so far as they relate to the posts of Nursing Sister in Kalawati Saran Education and Research, Delhi , except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of the Senior Nursing Officer, in the Kalawati Saran Children's Hospital ,New Delhi, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, namely:

1. Short title and commencement:- (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Kalawati Saran Children's Hospital , New Delhi , Senior Nursing Officer( Group – 'B' Post), Recruitment Rules 2021.  
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Application.- These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Number of posts, classification and level in pay matrix. – The number of the said posts, their classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule.

4. Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc. – The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

5. Disqualification. – No person, -

- a. who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- b. who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax. – Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. Saving. - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, the ex-servicemen and other special categories of person in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

(B) possessing the following educational qualification

(A)(I) B.Sc(Hons) in Nursing from a recognised university or institute; or regular course in B.Sc Nursing from a recognised university or institute; or post basic B.Sc Nursing from a recognised university or institute:-

(II) Registered as a nurse or nurse and mid-wife with State Nursing Council.

(B)(I) Diploma in General Nursing Mid-Wifery from a recognised Board or Council.

Note 1:- The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

Note 2:- The Period of deputation( including short term contract ) including period of deputation ( including short term contract) in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization or department of the central government shall ordinarily not to exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.
