Vacancy Circular

The Government of India has approved a scheme for strengthening the Drug Regulatory structures of the Central and State Governments with a view to ensuring quality, safety, efficacy or performance of medical products. One of the components of the Government approved scheme is setting up of a Training Academy for Drug Regulators, which will be responsible for conducting a series of Training and development programmes for drug regulatory and laboratory staff. programmes will inter alia include induction courses, refresher courses, professional development programmes, specialised courses in drug analysis, medical devices regulation and testing, biological products including stem cell/ medicine regenerative regulation, Manufacturing Practices, Good Laboratory Practices, Good Distribution Practices, Total Quality Management, etc., for different medical products. These programmes will aim at enhancing the knowledge and skill base of our regulators in terms of knowledge of domestic and international regulatory practices, clinical trial related regulations, training of Subject Expert Committee, Ethics Committees, etc.

2. The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has decided to appoint high calibre professionals to one post each of Director and Joint Director on contract basis, initially for a period of two years for commencing training programmes. The performance of the persons appointed will be reviewed at the end of first six months and further continuation of appointment will be contingent upon the outcome of review.

3. The positions of the Director and Joint Director are leadership positions and the two would be required to design a range of courses required for complete transformation of the drug regulatory landscape throughout the country and organise approved training programmes at different locations in the country.

4. The remuneration to the Director would, depending upon qualification and experience, be upto Rs. 2 lakes per month and that of the Joint Director upto Rs. 1.25 lakes per month.

5. Interested persons with requisite qualifications/experience (as per Annex) may submit their applications giving details of qualification/experience along with a write-up of around 1000 words on "Development of Human Resource for Drug Regulatory Structures in India – an action Plan" to Deputy Secretary (Drugs), Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Room No. 301 D, Nirman Bhavan, New Delhi – 110011 latest by April 30 2016.
