Terms Of Reference

2. Undertake field visits monitor programme progress.
3. Effective co-ordination with State/UT facilitators on a regular basis to support and facilitate technical support in the area of Quality Management.
4. Assist in facilitating organization of consultations, meeting, and workshops with different stakeholders, experts & consultants in Public Health
5. Carry out analysis of data and information and identify specific strategic measures and operational inputs for initiating/strengthening quality assurance systems.
6. Work closely with state teams in ensuring provision of timely inputs to the preparation of program and assessments reports.
7. Any other responsibility as may be allocated by Advisor (PH-QI) from time to time.
8. Though the current position is based in NHSRC New Delhi. However, the selected candidate may be located / transferred to any State at a later stage, as per need of the organisation.

Eligible/Specifications for the post:

- Posses a Medical/ Dental/ Ayush degree from a reputed Institute with a lead Auditor in ISO 9001 systems.
- Have atleast 2 years experience of facilitating and implementation of Quality Management system in Public Health Facilities, preferably in more than one state.
- Training / Course in Healthcare Quality / Advance Hospital Management Degree would be an advantage.
- Maximum of 40 years of age at the time of selection.
