G.S.R.....- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules to amend the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Central Research Institute, Kasauli, Upper Division Clerk, Group 'C' Post, Recruitment Rules, 2017, namely:-

1. (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Central Research Institute, Kasauli, Upper Division Clerk, Group 'C' post, Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2022.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Central Research Institute, Kasauli, Upper Division Clerk, Group 'C' post, Recruitment Rules, 2017,-

(a) in the Schedule, in column(12), for the column heading and the entries relating thereto, the following column heading and entries shall be substituted, namely:-

If a Departmental Promotion Committee exists, what is its composition

Group 'C' Departmental Promotion Committee (for considering promotion) consisting of:-

- (1) Assistant Director (Non-Medical), Central Research Institute, Kasauli - Chairman;
- (2) Deputy Assistant Director (Non-Medical), Central Research Institute, Kasauli - Member;
- (3) Administrative Officer/ Officer-in-Charge (Administration), Central Research Institute, Kasauli-Member;
- (4) Commanding Officer, Military Hospital, Kasauli or his Representative - Member.
