



**NOTIFICATION**

New Delhi, the

G.S.R. .... – In exercise of the power conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of Dental Posts Recruitment Rules, 1997, Directorate General of Health Services (Maxillofacial Surgeon), Recruitment Rules, 1985 and amendments made therein, except in respect of things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the terms and conditions of Dental Posts Recruitment Rules, namely:-

1. **Short title and commencement : ---**

- (i) These rules may be called the Dental Posts Recruitment Rules, 2015.
- (ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette except the provisions relating to promotion in various Grades under the Dynamic Assured Career Progression Scheme which is effective from 29.10.2008.

2. **Application** --- These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column 1 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. **Classification and the scale of pay**---- The number of posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto, shall be as specified in Colum (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

4. **Method of recruitment age-limit and other qualification etc.**---- the method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

## **5. Disqualification:**

No person, ---

(a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person

shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said posts

Provided that the Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

## **6. Power to relax:**

Where the Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

## **7. Saving**

Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes the other backward classes, the ex-servicemen and special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in this regard.
