NOTIFICATION

G.S.R......In exercise of powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Central Health Service Rules, 2014, namely:-

- (1) These rules may be called the Central Health Service (Amendment) Rules, 2016.
- (2) These shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

In the Central Health Service Rules, 2014, under Rule-7 - Filling of Duty Posts by Deputation (including short term contract), following entry shall be inserted below Rule 7:-

- 7 (1) The deputation would be on either of the following grounds:
 - i. Against Vacancy Circular issued by the Ministry from time to time.
 - ii. Under spouse category: where one of the spouse should belong to -

All India Service; other Central Services; posts and services under the Central Government; Indian Armed Forces; Autonomous Bodies; Public Sector Undertakings; or any entity owned and controlled by the Central Government, etc.

And, the other spouse working as a doctor registered with Medical Council of India/State Medical Council in Allopathic system of Medicine may belong to:

either any of the above services/posts other than All India Service, or any State Government or any Institution owned and controlled by the State Government.
