अकादमिक वर्ष 2016-17 में ब्रौड स्पेशियेलिटि कोर्सेज (एमडी/एमएस/डिप्लोमा) में नये कोर्स शुरू करने एवं मौजूदा सीटों में वुद्धि करने के लिए किए गए आवेदन पत्रों की वर्तमान स्थिति के संदर्भ में।

सर्वसाधारण को यह सूचित किया जाता है कि भारतीय आयुर्विज्ञान परिषद(एमसीआई) के द्वारा केन्द्र सरकार को अकादमिक वर्ष 2016-17 के दौरान ब्रौड स्पेशियेलिटि कोर्सेज (एमडी/एमएस/डिप्लोमा) में नये कोर्स शुरू करने एवं मौजूदा सीटों में वुद्धि करने के लिए सिफारिश भेजने की अंतिम तिथि 31 जनवरी, 2016 है। दिनांक 22.01.2016 तक इस मंत्रालय को कुल 174 पाठयक्रमों को स्वीकृति पत्र जारी करने के लिए सिफारिशें प्राप्त हो चुकी है, जिनका विवरण एवं वर्तमान स्थिति संलग्नक में देखी जा सकती है।

मेडिकल कॉलेज जिन्होंने अभी तक वांछित बैंक गारंटी एवं संबंधित दस्तावेज इस मंत्रालय में नहीं जमा की है, उन्हें अतिशीघ्र जमा करने की सलाह दी जाती है। मेडिकल कॉलेज जिनको भारतीय आयुर्विज्ञान परिषद द्वारा सिफारिश की जा चुकी है किन्तु इस मंत्रालय के द्वारा बैंक गारंटी एवं संबंधित दस्तावेज जमा करने के लिए पत्र नहीं मिला है, उन्हे भी बैंक गारंटी एवं संबंधित दस्तावेज तैयार करने की सलाह दी जाती है।

शेष पाठयक्रमों के आवेदन अभी मंत्रालय में विचाराधीन हैं जिसमें मंत्रालय द्वारा व्यक्तिगत सुनवाई/एमसीआई द्वारा निरीक्षण के दौरान पायी गई कमियों को दूर करने के सत्यापन/एमसीआई के द्वारा पुनः लोकन शामिल है।

मेडिकल कॉलेजों को बैंक गारंटी एवं संबंधित दस्तावेज जमा करने के लिए जारी किए हुए पत्र/स्वीकृति पत्र/अस्वीकृति पत्र समय समय पर मंत्रालय के वेबसाईट पर उपलब्ध कराए जाएंगे। आवेदकों को यह सलाह दी जाती है कि वेबसाईट पर सूचना पाते ही बैंक गारंटी एवं संबंधित दस्तावेज जमा करने की प्रक्रिया आरंभ कर दें।

Note:- All the above Medical Colleges/Institutes whose name figured in column (B) and LOP has not been issued, are required to furnish the following documents undertaking for getting the Letter of Permission (LOP) by the Central Government.

- (i) The applicant should provide all infrastructural facilities in terms of teaching and non-teaching staff, buildings, equipment and hospital facilities as per Medical Council of India norms.
- (ii) No student should be admitted in the above course till the formal permission of the Central Govt. is granted.

The Private Medical College should provide **Bank Guarantee of required amount in favour of Medical Council of India, New Delhi valid for three years from a nationalized/scheduled Bank as per MCI's norms.** However, medical colleges/institutions governed by the State Govt. are required to furnish only an undertaking to provide funds in their plan budget till the facilities are fully provided as per time bound programme indicated by them.
- (iii)

The Medical Colleges/institutions will provide undertaking to implement the decision regarding payment of stipend to the PG students similar to PG students of Govt. Medical colleges in their State.

(iv) The Govt. Medical College(s) (except those colleges located in Andhra Pradesh, Telangana & J&K) should give an undertaking authorising Medical Counselling Committee (MCC), Directorate General of Health Services, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India to include 50% of PG (Medical) seats in All India Quota PG seats for the year 2016

IMPORTANT:

Last date for issuing LOP for the above PG courses by Central Government is 28.02.2016 for academic session 2016-17. The colleges are required to furnish above documents immediately and well before stipulated time show that LOP may be issued with in time. Formal letter in this regard will be follow.
