Eligibility:

- (i) Pass in 10th standard or High School examination or equivalent.
- (ii) Successful Completion of ANM/Health Worker (Female) Training course from an Institution, recognized by Indian Nursing Council/State Nursing Council
- (iii) Registration with Indian/State Nursing Council as ANM/Health Worker (F) both in Nursing and Midwifery.
- (iv) Those who have appeared in final ANM Exam 2013, are also apply.

Age: 18 to 25 years (Relaxable for Govt. Servant upto 35 years)

Desirable: Working knowledge in Hindi.

The posts will be filled up on regular basis and the Pay & Allowance will be paid as per Central Govt. Rules, as amended from time to time. The eligible candidates may be short listed through a screening test following by written test/Interview.

Selection will be based upon Marks Obtained in the Written Examination & Interview to be held at this centre. 100 marks will be for the written examination and 25 marks for the interview. The proportionate weightage will also be given for experience in National Health Programmes, for the marks in the interview. Decision of the selection committee, in this matter will be final.

Note:-

1. The qualification regarding experience is relaxable at the discretion of the competent authority in case of candidates belonging to the SC/ST category if, at any stage of selection, the competent authority is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing the requisite experience are not available to fill up the vacancies reserved for them.
2. The qualification regarding experience is also relaxable at the discretion of the competent authority in case of candidates otherwise well qualified.
3. **To submit OBC certificate meant for job under Central Government.**
