NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 06 November, 2015

The following draft recruitment rules, which the Central Government proposes to make, in exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, for regulating the method of recruitment to the newly created post of Director (Vigilance) in the Central Drugs Standard Control Organisation, Directorate General of Health Services, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, after consultation with the Department of Personnel and Training, Union Public Service Commission and Ministry of Law and Justice, are hereby published for information of all persons likely to be affected thereby, and notice is hereby given that the said draft rules shall be taken into consideration on or after the expiry of a period of thirty days from the date of such publication in the website of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare.

The objections and suggestions which may be received from any person with respect to the said draft rules within the period specified above, shall be considered by the Central Government.

Draft rules

1. Short title and commencement. – (1) These rules may be called the Central Drugs Standard Control Organisation, Directorate General of Health Services, (Director (Vigilance) Recruitment Rules, 2015.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Application. - These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Number of post, classification, pay band and grade pay or pay scale. - The number of posts, their classification, the pay band and grade pay or pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule.

4. Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc. - The method of the recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the Schedule aforesaid.

5. Disqualification: No person, -

(a) who, has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living;
or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax. - Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. Saving. - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Schedules Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons, in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
