Subject: Nomination of candidates to undergo PGDPHM course (2023-24 session) at All India Institute of Hygiene & Public Health, Kolkata

The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare through National Health Mission (NHM) supports the Post Graduate Diploma in Public Health Management (PGDPHM) course conducted by consortium of partner Institutes like AIH&PH, Kolkata, NIHFV, JIPMER, Public Health Foundation of India etc. The Diploma course is for one year aimed at capacity building of mid-level health functionaries so as to address the gap in the Public Health Managerial capacity amongst health professionals in the country.

The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare as decided to continue to support the courses for the financial year 2023-24 @ Rs.3.00 lakh for Govt. Institutions viz. NIHFV/AIH&PH etc. as per Letter No..Z-18015/6/2023-NHM-II Dt. 06. March 2023 (copy enclosed). The details of the Institutes along with the number of seats and a note of the utility of the course for health functionaries is attached at Annexure –I and Annexure-II of the letter No..Z-18015/6/2023-NHM-II Dt. 06. March 2023 (copy enclosed).

In All India Institute of Hygiene and Public Health, Kolkata the Post Graduate Diploma in Public Health Management Course (2023-24 session) will commence from 1st August 2023.

Nominations are invited from the states affiliated to AIH&PH, Kolkata for the PGDPHM course for the year 2023- 24 ,Viz: West Bengal, Sikkim, Assam, Tripura & Andaman & Nicobar Islands (as per Annexure – I of Letter No.Z-18015/6/2023-NHM-II Dt. 06. March 2023)

It is requested to nominate seven candidates from your state to undergo the PGDPHM course.

The eligibility criteria for nominations vide Annexure-II of Letter No.Z-18015/6/2023-NHM-II Dt. 06. March 2023 are as follows:


1. Candidates working with the central, state, or local governments with at least three years of experience in health sector. Applicants should be MBBS/ BDS/AYUSH graduates or should

have passed B.Sc in nursing /health science/ natural sciences or Bachelors of occupational therapy /physiotherapy or MA in Social Sciences or an equivalent qualification.

2. Nursing staff, municipal corporation officers and other professionals working in health related organizations may also be considered for nominations.
3. Upper age limit may be kept as 50 years at the time of applying.
4. Willingness to serve in a Public Health Position after successful completion of the course
5. No other restriction should be imposed on the applicants- except bond to serve in the Govt after the course .

The course fee of Rs. 3.0 lakh per candidate, vide letter VideNo..Z-18015/6/2023-NHM-II Dt. 06. March 2023 is to be paid By DD Payable to The DIRECTOR, AIH&PH Kolkata at the time of reporting.


Subject: Proposal for the continuation of the Post Graduation Diploma in Public Health Management (PGDPHM) course in the academic year 2023-24-reg.

The undersigned is directed to say that the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare under the National Health Mission (NHM) support the Post Graduate Diploma in Public Health Management (PGDPHM) course conducted by Public Health Foundation of India (PHFI). The diploma course is a one year, full residential course aimed at capacity building of Mid-level health functionaries; so as to address the gap in the Public Health Managerial capacity amongst health professionals in the country with reputed partner Institutes.

2. Recognizing that the requirement of people with public health background in our public health facilities (also envisaged in Public Health Management Cadre) is a felt need, the Ministry has decided to continue support for the course for the financial year 2023-24 @ Rs. 3.00 lakh for Government Institutions viz National Institute of Health and Family welfare (NIHFW), New Delhi, Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (PGIMER) Chandigarh etc and Rs. 3.65 Lakhs for Private Institutions viz Indian Institute of Public Health (IIPH), Delhi and Hyderabad etc. The details of Institutes along with number of seats and a note on the utility of this course for health functionaries is attached at Annexure-I and II respectively.

3. It is requested to nominate and ensure participation of as many suitable officers as possible for the said programme. The State/UT Governments are expected to treat the nominated officers on duty. From the financial year 2016-17 onwards, nominated candidates have the flexibility to choose any of the partner Institutes and not merely the one assigned to the State/UT. The Selection Criteria for the nominations in PGDPHM Course will be the same as was for the last year 2022-23, as communicated vide this Ministry's D.O. No. Z-26015/9/2019-NRHM-III dated 15.12.2021.

ANNEXURE-II

**Post Graduate Diploma in Public Health Management
Proposed selection criteria for Government nominations in PGDPHM programme**

The partner institutions have felt that although eligibility criteria are spelt out, still many states have state-specific criteria and this limits the nomination of interested candidates to participate in PGDPHM program. In view of this, the partner institutions propose the following selection criteria for Government nominations in PGDPHM programme, which may also be included in the communication with the states for government nominations.

Proposed selection criteria for Government nominations in PGDPHM programme:

1. Candidates working with central, state or local governments with at least three years of experience in the health sector. Applicants should have MBBS, BDS, AYUSH graduates or B.Sc. in nursing/health science/natural sciences or Bachelor of occupational therapy/physiotherapy, or MA in social sciences or an equivalent qualification.
2. Nursing staff, municipal corporation officers and other professionals working in health-related organisations may also be considered for nominations.
3. Upper age limit may be kept as 50 years at the time of applying.
4. Willingness to serve in a Public Health position after successful completion of the course.
5. No other restriction should be imposed on the applicants - except bond to serve in the post after the course.
