

NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the2022

G.S.R.....- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Regional Leprosy Training and Research Institute, Gouripur, Bankura (Assistant Physiotherapist) post Recruitment Rules 1986, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Assistant Physiotherapist, the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Regional Leprosy Training & Research Institute, Gouripur, Bankura, West Bengal, namely: -

1. Short title and commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Regional Leprosy Training and Research Institute, Gouripur, Bankura, West Bengal, Assistant Physiotherapist (Group 'C' post) Recruitment Rules, 2022.

2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of post, classification, level in the pay matrix.- The number of said post, its classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto, shall be as specified in the columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualification, etc.- The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters, relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification.- No person,-

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other ground for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving.- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Schedule Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, the Ex-servicemen or any other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Note 2: In respect of posts, the appointments to which are made through the employment exchange the crucial date for determining the age limit shall, in each case, be the last date up-to which the Employment Exchange are asked to submit the names.	1.
