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NOTIFICATION

G.S.R.....- In the exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of Constitution, and in suppression of the Central Government Health Scheme, Delhi Physiotherapist (Grade-I) Recruitment Rules, 1995, except as respect things done or omitted to be done before such suppression, the President hereby makes following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Physiotherapist Grade-I in the Central Government Health Scheme, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare namely:-

1. Short title and commencement.-(1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Central Government Health Scheme, Physiotherapist Grade-I, Recruitment Rules, 2017.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of post, classification and scale of pay.- The Number of the said post ,its classification and the scale of attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the scheduled annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualification etc.- The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be specified in columns 5 to 13 of the aforesaid schedule.

4. Disqualification.- No person,-

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with other person

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for such doing exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of the person.

6. Savings. - Nothing in these rules shall effect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Schedules Castes, the Scheduled tribes, Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
