

NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the, 2022.

G.S.R.....-In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Regional Leprosy Training and Research Institute at Gauripur in Bankura District, West Bengal (Group 'C' and Group 'D' Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1985, in so far it relates to the post of Driver, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment and terms and conditions to the post of Staff Car Driver (Ordinary Grade) in the Regional Leprosy Training and Research Institute, Gouripur, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Regional Leprosy Training and Research Institute, Gouripur, Staff Car Driver (Ordinary Grade) (Group 'C' Post) Recruitment Rules, 2022.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of post, classification and level in pay matrix.- The number of said post, its classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc.- The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification.- No person,-

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person;

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving.- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Note 1- The qualification regarding experience is relaxable at the discretion of the competent authority.

Note 2: The qualification(s) regarding experience is relaxable at the discretion of the Competent Authority in the case candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes if at any stage of selection the Competent Authority is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancy reserved for them.

Medical Officer, Regional Leprosy Training and Research Institute, Gouripur- Member.	Not applicable

The Armed Forces Personnel due to retire or who are to be transferred to reserve within a period of one year and having the requisite experience and qualifications prescribed shall also be considered. Such persons would be given deputation terms upto the date on which they are due for release from the Armed Forces; Thereafter they may be continued on re-employment.

Note 1: The period of deputation including the period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization/ Department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years.

Note 2: The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation/ absorption shall be 'Not exceeding fifty-six years' as on the closing date of receipt of applications.
