G.S.R..... - In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of ECG Technician in the Lady Hardinge Medical College and Shrimati Sucheta Kriplani Hospital in New Delhi, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement. - (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare , Lady Hardinge Medical College and Shrimati Sucheta Kriplani Hospital , New Delhi, ECG Technician, (Group 'C' Post) Recruitment Rules, 2022.
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. Application. - These rules shall apply to the posts as specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
3. Number of posts, classification and level in pay matrix. - The number of the said posts, their classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule.
4. Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc. - The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.
5. Disqualification. - No person, -
 - a. who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living ; or
 - b. who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.
6. Power to relax. - Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing and relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
7. Saving .- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, the Ex-servicemen and other special categories of person in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Diploma in ECG Technology from a government recognized Institution/University and</p> <p>Three years' experience of handling cardiac equipment in a hospital of minimum 50 beds.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">or</p> <p>(b)Diploma in Electronics and Communication Engineering from a All India Council for Technical Education recognized University/ Institute and</p> <p>Two years' experience of handling cardiac equipment like 12 channel ECG, Cardiac monitor, Echo, Defibrillator, TMT and Holter machine in a minimum 50 beds in Medicine or Cardiology.</p> <p>Note 1 : Qualifications are relaxable at the discretion of the Staff Selection Commission or competent authority in case of candidates otherwise well qualified.</p> <p>Note 2 : The qualifications regarding experience are relaxable at the discretion of the Staff Selection Commission or competent authority in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes or the Scheduled Tribes if at any stage of selection the Staff Selection Commission or competent authority is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancy reserved for them.</p>
