G.S.R... – In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in suppression of the Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital, New Delhi (Hindi Officer)(Group 'B' Post),Recruitment rules,2004, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Assistant Director (OL), in the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital, New Delhi, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement. – (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital, New Delhi, Assistant Director (OL), (Group 'A' Post) Recruitment Rules, 2023.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of post, classification and level in pay matrix. – The number of the said post, its classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc. – The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification. – No person, -

- a. who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living;
or
- b. who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax. – Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission and relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving. – Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, the Ex-servicemen and other special categories of person in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Three years' experience of teaching in Hindi and English or research in Hindi or English under Central/State Governments/ Autonomous Body/ Statutory Organizations/PSU/Universities or recognized research or educational institutions.

Note 1: Qualifications are relaxable at the discretion of the U.P.S.C. in the case of candidates otherwise well qualified.

Note 2: The qualification (s) regarding experience is relaxable at the discretion of the U.P.S.C. in the case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes if at any stage of , U.P.S.C. is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancy reserved for them.

Desirable:

Studied one of the languages other than Hindi included in the 8th schedule of the Constitution at 10th level from a recognized Board.

Note 1:

The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, the deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

Note 2:

Period of deputation including the period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation or department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years.

Note 3 : The Maximum age-limit for appointment by deputation shall be 'Not exceeding 56 years' as on the closing date of receipt of applications.
