NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the.....,2021.

G.S.R.....- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the National Institute of Communicable Diseases, National Filaria Control Programme and National Malaria Eradication Programme, (Class I and Class II, Non-medical Gazetted Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1976, in so far as they relate to the post of Entomologist (Central Cross Checking Organisation) except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Entomologist (Central Cross Checking Organisation) in the National Center for Vector Borne Diseases Control, Delhi under the Directorate General of Health Services, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, namely :-

1. Short title and commencement . - (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, National Center for Vector Borne Diseases Control (NCVBDC), Delhi, Entomologist (Central Cross Checking Organisation) (Group 'A' Post) Recruitment Rules, 2021.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of post, classification and level in the pay matrix .- The number of the said post, its classification and the level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications etc.- The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification . - No person,-

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax. - Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving. - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, the Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Essential:-

(i) Masters degree in Zoology with Entomology as a paper from a recognised University or institute or Masters degree in Public Health Entomology.

(ii) Three years experience in teaching and/ or research and/ or control in the field of Medical Entomology or Public Health Entomology or Vector Borne Diseases under any of the scheme of the Centre or State Government or Union territory administrations or autonomous or statutory organizations or public sector undertakings or universities or recognized research institutes.

Desirable:-

Training in Advanced Medical Entomology/Vector Biology & Control/ Public Health Entomology or Vector Borne Diseases under any of the schemes of the Central Government/State Government.

Note-1: Qualifications are relaxable at Union Public Service Commission's discretion in case of candidates otherwise well qualified.

Note-2: The qualifications regarding experience are relaxable at the discretion of Union Public Service Commission, for reasons to be recorded in writing, in the case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes if at any stage of selection the Union Public Service Commission is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancies reserved for them.

Note: Vacancies caused by the incumbent being away on deputation or long illness or study leave or under other circumstances for a duration of one year or more may be filled on deputation basis from officers of Central Government,-

(a) (i) holding analogous posts on regular basis; or

(ii) with two years regular service in posts in level-8 of the pay matrix; and

(b) possessing the qualifications and experience prescribed for direct recruits.
