NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, Dated September, 2023

G.S.R In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the constitution, and in supersession of National Malaria Eradication Programme, Delhi (Group-A post) Recruitment Rules, 1986 in so far as they relates to the post of Assistant Director (OL)(Sl. No. 1), except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Assistant Director (OL) in the National Center for Vector Borne Diseases Control under the Directorate General of Health Services, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, namely.

1. Short title and commencement. - (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Directorate General of Health Services, National Center for Vector Borne Diseases Control, Assistant Director (OL) (Group-'A' Post) Recruitment Rules, 2023.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of post, classification and level in the pay matrix.- The number of the said post, its classification and the level in the pay matrix attached to the said post shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications etc.- The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification.- No person-

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving.- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Castes, the Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

(ii) Three year's experience of using / apply terminology (terminological work) in Hindi and translation work from English to Hindi or vice-versa, preferably or technical or scientific literature under Central/ State Governments/Autonomous body/ statutory Organization / PSUs /Universities or recognized research or educational institutions.

Or
Three year's experience of teaching in Hindi and English or research in Hindi or English under Central/State Governments/ Autonomous Body/ Statutory Organizations/ PSUs / Universities or recognized research or educational institutions.

Note 1: If the departmental Junior Translator in PB 3 Rs.9300-34800 and Grade pay of Rs.4200 with 8 years of regular service in the grade and having the educational qualification and experience prescribed for considering appointment on deputation basis is considered along with outsiders and if the departmental candidate is selected for appointment to the post, it shall be treated as having been filled by promotion.

Note 2: The period of the deputation including the period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization/department of the central government shall ordinarily not exceeding 3 years. The Maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the last date of receipt of applications.
