NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the , 2019

G.S.R.....- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Central Leprosy Teaching & Research Institute, Chingleput, (Ministerial/Group 'B posts) Recruitment Rules, 1984, in so far as it relates to Junior Accounts Officer, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Junior Accounts Officer, Central Leprosy Teaching & Research Institute, Chengalpattu, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement.-(1) These rules may be called the Central Leprosy Teaching & Research Institute, Chengalpattu, Junior Accounts Officer (Group 'B' Non-Gazetted, Non-Ministerial) Recruitment Rules, 2019.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of post, classification, level in pay matrix or scale of pay: The number of said post, its classification and Pay level in the pay matrix or pay scale attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications, etc. - The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in column (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualifications. - No person:

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax. - Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving. - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, the Ex-Servicemen or any other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Note 2: For the purpose of computing minimum qualifying service for promotion, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1st January, 2006 or the date from which the revised pay structure based on the Sixth Central Pay Commission recommendations has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding pay or pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the Pay Commission.

Deputation :

(A) Upper Division Clerks of Central Secretariat Clerical Service with eight years regular service in the grade; and

(b) who have undergone training in cash and accounts work in the Institute of Secretariat Training and Management or equivalent and possessing two years experience of cash, accounts and budget work; failing which,

B. Officers under the Central Government:-

(a) (i) holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre/department; or

(ii) with six years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a

confirmation) consisting of:

(1) Deputy Director General (Leprosy)-Chairman

(2) Director, CLTRI-Member

(3) Deputy Director/Assistant Director, CLTRI-Member

regular basis in level 6 in the pay matrix (Rs.35400-112400) of pay matrix or equivalent in the parent cadre or department;
(iii) with eight years' regular service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto in level 4 in in pay matrix (Rs.25500-81100) or equivalent in the parent cadre/department; and

(b) who have undergone training in cash and accounts work in the Institute of Secretariat Training and Management or equivalent course and possessing two years' experience of cash, accounts and budget work.

Note 1: The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, the deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

Note 2 : The period of deputation including the period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization/department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years. The Maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding fifty-six years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.

Note 3: For the purpose of appointment on deputation basis, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer

prior to 1st January, 2006 (the date from which the revised pay structure based on the Sixth Central Pay Commission recommendation has been extended) shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay or pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the Pay commission except where there has been merger of more than one pre-revised scale of pay into one grade with a common grade pay or pay scale and where this benefit will extend only for the post(s) for which that grade pay or pay scale is the normal replacement grade without any up-gradation.
