4.	Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc. - The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.
5.	Disqualification. – No person,-

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person having a spouse living, or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 6. **Power to relax.** Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 7. Saving.- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, ex-servicemen, Other Backward Class and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

- 2. **Application.** These rules shall apply to the post specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
- 3. **Number of posts, classification and level in pay matrix.** The number of the said post, their classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule.
- 4. **Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc.** The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.
- 5. **Disqualification.** No person, -
 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person having a spouse living, or
 - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

Deputation:

Officers from the Central/State Governments/UTs:-

- (a) (i) holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre/department; or
- (ii) with 3 years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in posts in Pay Level-7; and
- (b) Possessing the educational qualifications and experience prescribed for direct recruits under column 7.

Note 3:

The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, the deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

Note 4:

Period of deputation including the period of deputation in another excadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization or

department the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall not be 'Not exceeding 56 years' as on the closing date of receipt applications. Note 5: For the purpose of appointment on deputation basis, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1st January, 2006(the date from which the revised pay structure based on the Sixth Central Pay Commission recommendation has been extended) shall be deemed to be service rendered corresponding grade pay or pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the Pay commission except where there has been merger of more than one prerevised scale of pay into one grade with a common grade pay or pay scale and where this benefit will extend only for the post(s) for which that grade pay or pay scale is the normal replacement grade without any up gradation.
