## Notification

G.S.R..... In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Medical Record Officer in the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, the Central Institute of Psychiatry, Ranchi, namely:-

- Short title and commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Central Institute of Psychiatry, Kanke, Ranchi, Medical Record Officer (Group 'B' Post) Recruitment Rules, 2021.
  - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- Number of posts, classification and level in pay matrix. The number of the said post, its
  classification and level in the pay matrix or pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in
  columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
- 3. **Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc.** The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.
- 4. **Disqualification.** No person,-
  - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person having a spouse living; or (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- Power to relax. Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 6. Saving.- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

The departmental Medical Record Technician in level 4 in the pay matrix (Rs.25500-81100) with ten years of regular service in the grade and possessing the educational qualifications and experience prescribed for deputationists will also be considered alongwith and in case he or she is selected for appointment to the post, the same shall be deemed to have been filled by promotion.	
2. The period of deputation including the period of deputation in another excadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization / department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years.	
3. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation (including Short Term Contract) / absorption shall be 'Not exceeding 56 years' as on the closing date of receipt of applications.
