Madam,

In exercise of powers conferred upon the Oversight Committee (OC) under paragraph 105 of judgement of Supreme Court dated 02 May 2016 in Civil Appeal no. 4060 of 2009, OC has directed as follows;

- (i) In addition to the guidance provided in the Assessor's guide, Assessment reports should be prepared in two sets both of which, would be signed by the Assessor's as well as the Dean/ Authorised Representative of the college/Institution that is inspected/ assessed/ verified;
- (ii) One copy of the report signed by both the Assessor and Dean/Authorized Representative of the college concerned should be furnished by the Assessor to the latter under proper acknowledgement.
- (iii) In case, the applicant College/Institution finds grounds of disagreement with any findings of the Assessor, the former would be free to record its observations on the assessment report. The report of the Assessor alongwith the details of disagreement, if any, would be made available by the Assessor/s to MCI within 48 hours as prescribed in Assessor's guide.
- (iv) The fresh team of Assessors/ Compliance verifiers shall be distinct from the team that conducted the initial inspection.
- (v) Computer generated random number may be used for selection of fresh Assessors.
- (vi) The directives would apply to all inspections, assessments and compliance verifications that would becarried out with effect from the date of issue.
- 2. This directive of OC may be displayed prominently in the website of MCI, immediately and the fact confirmed to OC.
- 3. This issues with the approval of OC.
