General public is hereby informed that this Ministry, in consultation with Dental Council of India (DCI) has decided to lower the qualifying cut-off percentile for NEET-MDS, 2020 by **18.935** percentile for each category (General, SC/ST/OBC and UR-PWD), in pursuance of the 2<sup>nd</sup> proviso in clause 7(1) of DCI's Master of Dental Surgery Course (1<sup>st</sup>Amendment) Regulations, 2018. The qualifying percentiles for NEET-MDS, 2020 for the academic session 2020-21 now stand lowered as under:

UR-PWD	26.065
