2. The Letters of Intent (LoI) will be issued to the Colleges after receiving the approval of the competent authority calling for the following documents/undertakings:

- i. The applicant should provide all infrastructural facilities in terms of teaching and non-teaching staff, building, equipment and hospital facilities as per norms of DCI;
- ii. No student should be admitted in the above course till the formal permission of the Central Government is granted;
- iii. The Private Dental College should provide Bank Guarantee of required amount in favour of the Dental Council of India, New Delhi valid for the entire duration of the course from a Nationalised/ Scheduled Bank. For Dental Colleges/Institutions which are governed by State Government, an undertaking shall be made by the concerned State Government to provide funds in their Plan Budget regularly till facilities are fully provided as per the time bound programme in the DCI's norms against starting/ Increase in seats in the above said MDS course;
- iv. The Dental Colleges/ Institutions will provide an undertaking to implement any decision of the Dental Council of India/ Central Government regarding payment of stipend to the PG students.

3. All the above Colleges are, therefore, advised to be ready to furnish the above documents to the Ministry at short notice so that LoPs can be issued by 28.02.2021.
