PUBLIC NOTICE

General public is hereby informed that this Ministry, in consultation with the Dental Council of India (DCI), has decided to lower the qualifying cut-off percentile for NEET-UG 2019 for admissions to BDS courses by **10.00** percentile for each category (General, SC/ST/OBC and General candidates with Bench Mark Disabilities specified under the *Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016*), in pursuance of the clause (b) of Chapter 6: Merit List and Qualifying Criteria of the Information Bulletin for NEET (UG) – 2019. The qualifying percentiles for NEET-UG 2019 for admissions to BDS courses for the academic session 2019-20 now stand lowered as under:
