**PUBLIC NOTICE**

General public is hereby informed that this Ministry, in pursuance of the 2<sup>nd</sup> proviso to Regulation 7(1) of the Dental council of India, Master of Dental Surgery Course (1<sup>st</sup> Amendment) Regulations, 2018, has decided to lower the qualifying cut-off percentile for NEET-MDS, 2021 by **23.029 percentile** for each category (General, SC/ST/OBC and UR-PWD). The qualifying percentiles for NEET-MDS, 2021 for the academic session 2021-22 now stand lowered as under:

S. No.	Category	Qualifying Percentile
1.	General (UR/EWS)	26.971
2.	SC/ST/OBC (Including PWD of SC/ST/OBC)	16.971
3.	UR-PWD	21.971

2. The National Board of Examinations has been requested to bring out the revised results in accordance with the above lowered qualifying percentiles.

3. Since, the last date of joining in MDS courses for academic session 2021-22 is 10.11.2021, this Ministry, in pursuance of the powers conferred to it as per Dental council of India (Establishment of New Dental Colleges. Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity in Dental Colleges) Regulations, 2006, has decided to extend the last date upto which students can be admitted/joined in MDS courses for academic session 2021-22 against stray vacancies arising due to any reason to **20<sup>th</sup> November 2021**.
