**NOTIFICATION**

New Delhi, the ....., 2019

**G.S.R.....**-In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the **Regional Leprosy Training Research Institute (RLTRI), Babanpur (Aska), Odisha Plumber** Post, Recruitment Rules, 2001, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of **Plumber**, in the **RLTRI, Babanpur(Aska), Odisha**, namely:-

**1.Short title and commencement.**-(1) These rules may be called the **Regional Leprosy Training and Research Institute, Babanpur (Aska), Odisha Plumber** Group-C, Non-Gazetted post, Recruitment Rules, 2019.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

**2.Number of post, classification and scale of pay.**- The number of said post, its classification and the scale of pay attached there to shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed hereto.

**3.Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications, etc.**- The method of recruitment, age limit, qualification and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns 5 to 13 of the said Schedule.

**4.Disqualifications.**-No person,

(a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, except any person from the operation of this rule.

**5.Initial Constitution** – Person holding the post of **Plumber** in the **Regional Leprosy Training and Research Institute, Aska** on regular basis on the date of commencement of these rules shall be deemed to have been appointed to the post

according to these rules and the regular service rendered by them shall count for the purpose of probation period, qualifying service for promotion, confirmation and pension.

**10.Power to relax.**- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

**11.Saving.**- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the scheduled Tribes, Ex-serviceman, Other Backward Classes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
