NOTICE

This Ministry proposes to frame the Recruitment Rules for the newly created post of Deputy Director, Group 'A', Level 12 (Rs. 78,800-2,09,200) in the Central Drugs Testing Laboratory, Mumbai under the Central Drugs Standard Control Organisation, Directorate General of Health Services. The draft Notification and Recruitment Rules for the post are enclosed.

Notification

G. S. R.....:- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Deputy Director in the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Central Drugs Testing Laboratory, Mumbai , namely: -

1. Short title and commencement. – (1) These rules may be called the Directorate General of Health Services, Central Drugs Laboratory, Mumbai, Deputy Director, Group 'A' Post Recruitment Rules, 2018.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of post, classification, Level in pay matrix .- The number of post, its classification , the level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit, other qualifications, etc. – The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification. – No person,-

- (a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
- (b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax. – Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving. – Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Schedule Tribes, ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Note 1:Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.

Deputation (Including short term contract)

Officers under the Central/ State Governments/ Union Territories/ Recognized Research Institutions/ Public Sector Undertakings/ Semi-Government/ Statutory or autonomous organisations:-

(a)(i) holding analogous post on regular basis in the

parent cadre/
department; or

(ii) with three years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in Level 11 or equivalent in the parent cadre/department; and

(b) possessing the following educational qualifications and experience:-

(i) Master's degree in Pharmacy or Biotechnology or Chemistry or Biochemistry or Pharmaceutical Chemistry or Pharmacology or Microbiology of a recognized University/Institute; and

(ii) 5 Years' experience in testing of Drugs/Cosmetics.

Note 1: The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation (including short-term contract). Similarly, the deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for

<p>appointment by promotion.</p> <p>Note2:(The period of deputation (Including Short Term Contract) including period of deputation (Including Short Term Contract) in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation or department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not to exceed four years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation (Including Short Term Contract) shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.</p>
