Notification

G.S.R..... In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Port and Airport Health Organisations in India (Group 'B') Recruitment Rules, 2003, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Health Inspector in the Port, Airport Health Organisations and Land Border Quarantine Centers under the Directorate General of Health Services, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement, - (i) These rules may be called the Port, Airport Health Organisations and Land Border Quarantine Centres (Group 'B') Recruitment Rules, 2018.
(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. Application, - These rules shall apply to the post specified in the Schedule.
3. Number of posts, classification, and pay matrix level, - The number of said posts, its classification and pay matrix level attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the said Schedule annexed to these rules.
4. Method of recruitment, age limit and qualifications etc., - The method of the recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns 5 to 13 of the aforesaid Schedule annexed to these rules.
5. Disqualification, - No person, -

(a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) Who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax, - Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules, with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. Saving, - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
