NOTIFICATION

G.S.R. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Central Government Health Scheme (Accounts Officer) Recruitment Rules, 1996, except as respect things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Accounts Officer in the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Central Government Health Scheme, namely:-

- 1. Short title and commencement. (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Central Government Health Scheme Organisation (Accounts Officer) Recruitment Rules, 2018.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Number of post, classification and level in the Pay Matrix. The number of the said post, its classification and level in the Pay Matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
- 3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications etc. . The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.
- 4. **Disqualification.** No person,-
- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- **5. Power to relax.** Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- **6. Savings.** Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concession required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, the Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion (The period of deputation including the period of deputation in another Ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization/department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years). The maximum age limit for appointment by transfer on deputation shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.
