



Notification

G.S.R. – In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, and in supersession of the All India Institute of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, Bombay (Class III and Class IV Posts) Recruitment Rules 1968, in so far as they relate to the post of Drivers except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Drivers in the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, All India Institute of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, Mumbai, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement. – (1) These rules may be called the Staff Car Driver (Ordinary Grade) in the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, All India Institute of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, Mumbai, Recruitment Rules, 2022.  
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. Number of posts, classification and level in the pay matrix. – The number of the said posts, their classification and the level in pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualification, etc. – The method of recruitment, age limit, qualification, and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.
4. Disqualification. – No person, -
  - a. who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living ; or
  - b. who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax. – Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
6. Saving .- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, the Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Such persons would be given deputation terms upto the date on which they are due for release from the Armed Forces, thereafter they may be continued on re-employment.</p> <p>Note 1.- The period of deputation including the period of deputation in another Ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation or department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceeding three years. The maximum age-limit for deputation shall be not exceeding fifty six years as on the closing date of the receipt of application.</p> <p>Note 2.- The departmental official in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.</p> <p>Note 3.- For the purposes of appointment on deputation basis, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to the 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2006, the date from which the revised pay structure based on the Sixth Central Pay Commission recommendations has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay or pay scale extended based on the recommendations</p>

	of the Seventh Central Pay Commission except where there has been merger of more than one pre-revised scale of pay into one grade with a common grade pay or pay scale, and where this benefit will extend only for the post for which that grade pay or pay scale is the normal replacement grade without any upgradation.
