

G.S.R. - In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Animal Supervisor in the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, BCG Vaccine Laboratory, Guindy, Chennai namely: -

1. Short title and commencement .- (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, BCG Vaccine Laboratory, Guindy, Chennai, Animal Supervisor (Group 'C' Post), Recruitment Rules, 2019.

(2) They shall come into the force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of post, classification, level in the pay matrix.- The number of post, its classification and the level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc.- The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.

4. Disqualification.- No person,-

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of these rules.

5. Power to relax .- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving.- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Similarly deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion. <b>Note2:</b> Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other Organization/ Department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years. <b>Note3:</b> The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of the receipt of applications.</p>	Group 'C' Departmental Promotion Committee for considering/ promotion/ confirmation consisting of:- (i) Director, BCGVL, Chennai : Chairman (ii) Administrative Officer, BCGVL, Chennai : Member (iii) Veterinarian, BCGVL, Chennai : Member (iv) Gazetted Officer from Central/ State Government : Member	Not applicable
