PUBLIC NOTICE

General public is hereby informed that this Ministry, in exercise of powers conferred to it under footnote (2) below the time schedule stipulated in Dental Council of India (Establishment of New Dental Colleges. Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity in Dental Colleges) Regulations, 2006, has decided to extend the last date for issue of Letters of Permission/Renewal Permissions or otherwise in respect of BDS Schemes/Renewals for academic year 2020-21 to 15.10.2020.

2. It is also informed that the following Schemes for increase of seats in BDS course for the academic session 2020-21 have been recommended by Dental Council of India (DCI) which have been submitted to the competent authority in the Ministry for consideration/ approval:

3. The Letters of Intent (LoI) will be issued to the Colleges after receiving the approval of the competent authority calling for the following documents/undertakings:

- i. The teaching and non-teaching staff shall be recruited as per DCI norms.
- ii. The applicant has a feasible and time bound programme to provide additional equipment and infrastructure facilities as per DCI norms.

- iii. State Government or UT Administration shall furnish an undertaking to provide funds in its Plan budget regularly till facilities are fully provided as per the time bound programme indicated by it.
- iv. Admission in BDS Course with increased intake shall be made only after receipt of formal permission from the Central Government.

4. All the Colleges mentioned in para:2 above are, therefore, advised to be ready to furnish the above documents to the Ministry at a short notice so that Letters of Permission can be issued by 15.10.2020.
