G.S.R.No..... In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the President of India hereby makes the following rules, regulating the post of Chief Physiotherapist of Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement. – (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi, Chief Physiotherapist, (Group 'A' Post), Recruitment Rules, 2024.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of post, classification and level in pay matrix. – The number of the said post, its classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc. – The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification . – No person, -

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.– Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving. – Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

**Note:** Where junior who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years, whichever is less and have successfully completed their probation period, for promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.

Deputation (including short term contract) : Officer of the Central Government or State Government or Union Territory Administration or autonomous or statutory organizations or public sector undertakings or Universities or recognized Research Institutions:

(a) (i) Holding analogous post on regular basis in the parent cadre or department; or

(ii) With five years regular service in Level-11 of pay matrix (Rs. 67700-208700/-) in the parent cadre or department, and;

(b) Master Degree in Physiotherapy in any branch from a recognized university or institute with 03 years practical experience of holding clinical post in at least 50- bedded hospital

Note 1: The period of deputation including period of deputation in another Ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization or department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years.

Note 2: The maximum age-limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding fifty-six years as on the last date of receipt of application.
