NOTIFICATION

G.S.R In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the constitution, and in supersession of National Malaria Eradication Programme, Delhi (Group- C posts) Recruitment Rules, 1980 in so far as they relates to the post of **Statistical Assistant (Sl.No.5)** except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Statistical Assistant in the National Vector Borne Disease Control Programme, (NVBDPC), under the Directorate General of Health Services, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, namely.

1. Short title and commencement : -

(i) These rules may be called the National Vector Borne Disease Control Programme, **Statistical Assistant, Group 'B' Post** Recruitment Rules, 2019

(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of post, classification and level in the Pay Matrix- The number of post, its classification and the level in the Pay Matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of Recruitment, age-limit, qualifications etc.:- The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of Schedule.

4. Disqualification: - No person:-

(i) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person having a spouse living, or

(ii) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax: - Where the central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving: - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time In this regard.

No. 2)**, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of **Store Superintendent** in the National Vector Borne Disease Control Programme, (NVBDCP), under the Directorate General of Health Services, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, namely.

1. Short title and commencement : -

(i) These rules may be called the National Vector Borne Disease Control Programme, **Store Superintendent, Group 'B' Post** Recruitment Rules, 2019.

(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of post, classification and level in the Pay Matrix- The number of post, its classification and the level in the Pay Matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of Recruitment, age-limit, qualifications etc.:- The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of Schedule.

4. Disqualification: - No person:-
